Important Bus Information

From Monday 21st October to Friday 25th October Station Lane, Hedon will be closed. As you know we have now migrated to Arbor to use the behaviour and rewards module, one of the reasons is to support parents/carers to have everything in one place. As with all migrations, we are working hard to ensure we maximise its potential and make things as easy as possible for its users. We have noticed that it appears that detentions are given for a range of reasons, such as not having the correct equipment. However, Arbor only communicates this, in that way, when a student receives a 5th comment in the week. For example:

STUDENT NAME has an Afterschool Detention on 22 Oct 2024, 15:00 - 16:00 for Lack of equipment.

Lack of equipment in isolation is not a detention but when it is the 5th comment that week, it will be communicated this way.
